Drawbridge area

Chairman Landers is concerned about the new sand accumulating along the outside edge as the eel grass and scallop habitat is gone.

Constable Grunden said that two years ago Middlesex questioned that they did it but the EPA has statistics on the area prior to the drawbridge work. He added that the EPA was upset about the damage and they would be on island in July.

Member Alwardt said that he thinks the Towns will have to dredge.

Little Bridge

Constable Grunden advised that the permit allows for three days of sand removal from the channel after June 1st.

Member Alwardt asked that buoys be placed in Sengekontacket on the town line.

Other

Constable Grunden said that staff wears the same shirts in the summer that indicate "Shellfish Department" on them with Town seal.
