### Review of Eligibility Applications

\*Veira Park. It was brought up that this application listed items that were in need of repair. Joan clarified that DPA funds could not be used for maintenance. Paul said he would get back to them explaining that the application as written could not be approved, however, they could submit an application that involved new items and not maintenance of existing structures/equipment.

\*Union Chapel Park Joan stated, and it was agreed, that this does fall within the guidelines of CPA monies.

\*Michigan State University. The question was asked when this is all said and done what do we have? Joan stated that this is not Open Space but could be Historic Preservation. However, the question is what are we preserving and what are we spending money on that will benefit the general public. Paul said he will tell them in his response that they will need to answer that question.

\*Harbor Homes of Martha's Vineyard. Definitely eligible.

\*Aquinnah Parks and Recreation Committee. The question was asked just how much kids from Oak Bluffs would utilize this, however Joan stated that this does meet the guidelines and could move forward.

Recruitment of additional at-large committee member. Joan said we can ask Deb if she can put an ad in the paper. Paul said that if she can't we could put an ad in the paper and put something on the webpage.
